OUR PURPOSE


To provide girls with the opportunity to learn and play hockey in an environment of equal participation and competitiveness and to instill in them the ideal of individual achievement, team play, and sportsmanship.





OUR PHILOSOPHY

Maximize player development with a fun, competitive program that strikes a healthy balance with travel, time commitment, and affordability











PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

Is a top objective of our program:

- Age-appropriate skill development thru practices that follow USA Hockey's "American Development Model"
- Place players and teams at the level that provides the best opportunity for development
- 70/30 rule: attempt to place teams at appropriate competitive level so not to have a team win more than 70% of their games or less than 30%







- USA Hockey: American Development Model
- D1 Training Alexandria: optional off-ice strength and conditioning program
- Ice Hockey Systems: coaching tools and resources













SEASON SCHEDULE

Runs mid-August to early March, and includes:

- 40-50 practices (typically 2 practices/week, either 1 weeknight and 1 weekend, or 2 weeknight)
- 25+ games: combination of league games, non-league games, and tournaments. Older teams typically play more games than younger teams. Please expect most or all non-league games to be "away" games.
- Holiday breaks during Thanksgiving weekend and ~10 days around Christmas and New Years







- Expect 2-3 tournaments/trips, with a mix of local and overnight experiences
- Individual teams will decide which tournaments/trips, and how many, to attend
